ABOUT WEST

Hammersmith & Fulham (H&F) is a London Borough of wide disparities, with an acute need for youth services. This vast difference between those living in different parts of our borough can lead to radically different life outcomes. **WEST Youth Zone** is a vital provision that will make a huge impact on the lives of young people, and on the whole borough, levelling the playing field for our young people.

WEST, we believe all young people in West London should have
the opportunity to discover their passion and their purpose and
be able to explore where it can take them.

Our Youth Zone is a purpose-built space fizzing with energy and crammed with incredible facilities. **Staffed by talented, skilled and dedicated youth workers** who truly believe in young people, helping them see what they could achieve, and giving them the skills, confidence and ambition to go for it.

Open 7 days a week, while schools are closed - that's evenings and weekends, plus all through the school holidays. We offer a **safe and active space for young people** to flourish in their leisure time, where their interests can be nurtured, and they can grow as individuals. This is a charity that the whole community can be proud of, and you can be part of that journey.

We give 8 to 19-year-olds, (and up to 25 for young people with additional needs) affordable access to a broad range of sport, arts and mental health support, and employability services, designed to empower them to lead healthier, positive and more active lives – raising their aspirations for themselves and their community.





THE ROLE

West Youth Zone offers both a nutritious hot meal and a tuck shop service on every session that we run. Whilst the Kitchen Supervisor cooks the food, the Catering Assistants serve the food and are integral to the successful operation of catering for the young people. You will be responsible for food hygiene, using the EPOS machine to sell items and manage stock, serving food, interacting with young people, washing up and keeping the kitchen clean, doing statutory paperwork and cashing up. Depending on the rota and your own cooking abilities, there may also be opportunities for you to teach cooking to young people directly in our training kitchen.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to Kitchen Supervisor

- To undertake the preparation of food and beverages served in the café / tuck area
- To serve food and beverages to West Youth Zone members, ensuring they receive a great level of customer service
- · To assist with menu planning
- To comply with stock control procedures
- Ensure all kitchen equipment is regularly cleaned, reporting any faults/repairs required
- Ensure all Health and Safety and Environmental Health requirements are adhered to, namely:
 - 1. Reporting of all equipment not working properly
 - 2.o Reporting of any health and safety issues
 - 3. Compliance with food hygiene regulations
 - 4. Ensuring food is stored correctly and at correct temperatures
 - Recording temperatures on delivery of all high-risk food and prior to service, where applicable
- To assist with the monitoring of all stock
- · Cash handling in line with WEST Youth Zone financial procedures
- Maintaining a clean working environment as set out in the cleaning schedule by ensuring regular cleaning of all work surfaces, storerooms and ancillary areas
- · Clearing tables and washing up
- Any other duties that may be required
