ABOUT WEST

Hammersmith & Fulham (H&F) is a London Borough of wide disparities, with an acute need for youth services. Our Youth Zone is a purpose-built space fizzing with energy and crammed with incredible facilities. **Staffed by talented, skilled and dedicated youth workers** who truly believe in young people, helping them see what they could achieve, and giving them the skills, confidence and ambition to go for it.

Open 7 days a week, while schools are closed - that's evenings and weekends, plus all through the school holidays. We offer a **safe and active space for young people** to flourish in their leisure time, where their interests can be nurtured, and they can grow as individuals. This is a charity that the whole community can be proud of, and you can be part of that journey.

We give 8 to 19-year-olds, (and up to 25 for young people with additional needs) affordable access to a broad range of sport, arts and mental health support, and employability services, designed to **empower them to lead healthier**, **positive and more active lives** – raising their aspirations for themselves and their community.





THE ROLE

The Deputy Head of Youth Work (Targeted & Partnerships) is a crucial role sitting within the WEST Youth Zone Delivery Team. Reporting to the Head of Youth Work, you will be responsible for closely supporting the co-ordination, planning and delivery of an exceptional seven day per week youth offer within a state-of-the-art multi-million-pound centre.

Through line management of your team and in collaboration with partners, the successful post holder will ensure that WEST is accessed by all young people who need it the most. You will oversee our community engagement outreach as part of our delivery ensuring WEST continues to have a strong reputation and there remains a good awareness of our offer.

You will also be accountable for ensuring strong evidence of effective performance in line with our vision, mission, values, and strategic objectives and that our team are afforded continuing professional development opportunities. You will need to be a big voice within a large team, owning and demonstrating a strong ethos, commitment, and dedication to improving the lives of children and young people and uniting them to fulfil their full potential. You will be confident in your abilities and able to deputise effectively for our Head of Youth Work as and when required. You will also be a Deputy Designated Safeguarding Officer for WEST.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Line management of Female Engagement, Employability, Inclusion
 Coordinator and Outreach. Ensuring they are highly motivated, creative and are themselves being excellent line managers to sessional staff.
- To ensure that monitoring, evaluation and reporting of all sessions including restricted-funding projects is completed as per the requirements of the funders
- To ensure the quality of the youth work offer across all direct report areas meet the standards of the organisation and supports ambitious attendance targets.
- To develop and maintain relationships and partnerships within West London, exploring areas for joint working where appropriate.
- To manage one off projects, events and promotional activities at WEST.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES CONTINUED

- To identify suitable restricted-funding projects that will enhance WEST's offer (liaising with the fundraising team where necessary), and to oversee the management of these projects.
- To support, and in some cases manage, targeted projects as and when they come up, including budget management, and ensuring full monitoring and evaluation compliance.
- To ensure that overall programme participation targets are consistently met, for example attendance targets.
- Representing WEST at external events and collaborating with the Head
 of Youth Work and Communications Manager to ensure WESTs
 messaging to young people and other stakeholders remains compelling.
- To oversee budget lines of direct reports.
- To work with the Head of Youth Work to prepare rotas that ensure all sessions are properly staffed and led.
- Working alongside the Head of Youth Work to ensure programmes are structured effectively and safely.
- To support the gathering of regular young people's stories within the Youth Zone.
- To lead sessions when required (usually this will be to cover annual leave or other staff absence).
- To produce the required reporting for Trustee and Board Sub-Committee meetings in a timely fashion
- To attend Delivery and team meetings.
- To ensure that the Delivery Team is properly upskilled and to work proactively to nip issues in the bud, working collaboratively with the Staff Training Manager and Head of HR.
- Champion our commitment to Equity, Diversity and Inclusion.
- · To deputise for the Head of Youth Work in their absence.
- To carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the Head of Youth Work
