ABOUT WEST

WEST Youth Zone, named Where Everyone Sticks
Together by local young people, opened in April 2024 - the
15th Youth Zone in the OnSide network. We are a purposebuilt space fizzing with energy and crammed with incredible
facilities. Staffed by talented, skilled and dedicated youth
workers who truly believe in young people, helping them see
what they could achieve, and giving them the skills, confidence
and ambition to go for it.

At WEST, we believe all young people in West London should have the opportunity to discover their passion and their purpose and be able to explore where it can take them. We are open 7 days a week, while schools are closed - that's evenings and weekends, plus all through the school holidays. We offer a safe and active space for young people to flourish in their leisure time, where their interests can be nurtured, and they can grow as individuals.

West London is an area of wide disparities, with an acute need for youth services. This vast difference between those living in different parts of our city can lead to radically different life outcomes. The London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham recognised this need and supported the build of the Youth Zone but do not fund ongoing running costs. As a charity, we manage a Patrons Programme and rely on mid/large scale corporate and private donations. These generous donations have so far enabled over 55,000 visits to the Youth Zone from young people from far and wide. We are committed to sustaining this year-round support, and ambitious to do even more. This is a charity that the whole community can be proud of, and you can be part of that journey.

- Follow guidance on good practice, transparency, risk, and ethical and legal compliance in fundraising.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Relationship building and networking: Act as a champion / ambassador for WEST, using your extensive personal or professional networks and influence to solicit funding support and generate warm leads for WEST in line with WEST's values and strategic priorities.
- Set up and steer a new Development Board: Work with our new Chair and the Head of Fundraising & Communications to set up and steer a Development Board of external advisors who will support with new introductions to help us meet our ambitious fundraising targets.
- Strategy and oversight: Contribute to the development, monitoring and evaluation of the fundraising strategy, ensuring alignment with the overall organisational strategy and financial plans as well as supporting the CEO and Head of Fundraising and offering constructive challenge.
- Governance and compliance: Serve on WEST's Board of Trustees as a
 Director, working collaboratively to provide excellent governance of the charity.
 Follow guidance to ensure that fundraising activity is legally compliant, ethical, in
 line with the Code of Fundraising Practice and meets best practice.
- Monitoring and reporting: Help shape the Fundraising Team's regular reports to the Board, asking probing questions and contributing to setting key performance indicators (KPIs) for fundraising to help ensure to transparency and accountability.
